#### She Walks In Beauty and Aesthetics in Life



is. In spite of the sad situation of losing a loved one the woman was in face of, the poet sang the praises of her instead of expressing pity unctuously, which shows a serene heart. Only the purest heart he had let the poet extol the real beauty.



"Exactly right" is another shining point. The most famous sentence in the poem is "One shade more,one ray less,had half impaired the nameless grace.", that reflected what called "exactly right". Sometimes we seek more or better and waste a lot of power and time. Actually what we are experiencing is the best.

"Byron's influence on European poetry, music, novels, operas and paintings have been immense, although the poet was widely condemned on moral grounds by his contemporaries." #### The **Woman** who Overcame the Gravitational Pulls of Color

When Star Trek first aired in the 1960s, communications officer Uhura (Nichelle Nichols) seemed to be the only Black woman affiliated( $\pi$ ,  $\pi$ ) with space travel. Little did society know that, as mathematicians, Black women such as Katherine Johnson made space flight feasible. Johnson, who was highlighted in the 2016 blockbuster ( $\pi$ ) fry  $\pi$ ) movie Hidden Figures, went aloft last year, aged 101. She left readers a gift. My Remarkable Journey is a masterful memoir of her well-lived life. Written with her daughters and an avared winning lower light it continues Lobescope for the proof of the proo award-winning journalist, it captures Johnson's story against the backdrop of a dramatic century of US history. It begins with exuberance (热情洋溢), describing how public recogni

changed her final years, from being honored with the Presidential Medal of Freedom to attending the Oscars in 2017 — and getting a kiss from President Barack Obama. After that, Johnson unfolds how a mathematics prodigy(  $\frac{4}{3}$ 7) barack Obama. After that, Johnson unfolos now a matematics produgy (新年) from White Sulphur Springs, West Virginia, became a 'human computer' for some of the most watched rocket launches in history. At NASA, she calculated trajectories and launch windows for the Project Mercury. Meanwhile, she had to navigate her own path in an age when segregation( 种族隔离) and disenfranchisement (剥夺特权) were legal in the US. Johnson recognizes that she is a role model, and that few women and people of color see their reflections in the sciences. She remembers she has to use idle times to prepare, to keep proving forwards when life hurt. Her down home (馬林姆), way of explaining moving forwards when life hurt. Johnson benefited from the sacrifices of her parents. She and her three siblings moved 190 kilometers to Institute, West Virginia, to attend a school for Black pupils that went beyond primary grades. Her father, who had gift for numbers, taught her that she was "equal to anyone, no matter what the laws or traditions aid". This lesson stabilized her trajectory.

Born in 1918, Johnson sat ringside to the Great Depression, the cold war, and the

US civil-rights movement, as well as the space race. Her life weaves through this greater tapestry, providing a deeper understanding of the past century.

Johnson joined the precursor (前身) to NASA in the summer of 1953. Even

before that, she shaped history. In 1939, she and two other Black students were

selected by the president of West Virginia State College, a historically Black institution, to attend the previously all white West Virginia University in Morgantown. Johnson's path to NASA was as significant as the work she did there.

She created a full life of friends and family. She leant on her community during handicaps, such as a house fire and her first husband's death. She cultivated camaraderie with other educated Black women in her university sorority, Alpha Kappa Alpha. And she was nurtured by Black colleges. Much achievement has been forged in these key institutions, Johnson illuminates this inspiring world, long overlooked by dominant narratives. Yes, she writes about the space race — but she also writes about spaces where others enabled her to thrive, and about race.

about race. Johnson overcame the gravitational pulls of gender and racial discrimination. Decades ago, after she completed her calculations for the rendezvous between the lunar and command module for the eventual Apollo mission to the Moon, she said "my part was done". With this final, beautiful opus, it is, indeed.

It is the honorable spirit that made her so admirable. Then we come to China, the most famous female politician

is certainly Wu Zhao, known as Wu Zetian. She is the only legitimate female emperor during 2000 years. Firstly becoming a concubine of the emperor, then changing her identity as the queen of the next emperor, finally becoming an emperor herself, Wu is a lady with a legendary story. With the ability and wisdom over the others, Wu finally achieved her dream to be the chairman of the country, and therefore proved that women can do all the work themselves. The only choice for people is to increase their consumption of high-quality and expensive
