Have you ever confused about the differences between Maocai and spicy hot pot? For me, I believed they are the same thing but called differently in the north and the south when I first tasted Maocai. But soon enough, I accepted the fact that they are different. Then I will share with you the differences between

Firstly, analyze it from the origins. Maocai is originated from Chengdu, Sichuan Province. During the cooking process, the cooked dish slowly rises to the surface, as if rising from water. And " Mao" means" rise" in Chinese so it got the name of Maocai. As for spicy hot pot, it

is from Leshan, Sichuan Province. Originally, boat trackers used local ingredients and scalded them to eat. Little by little, spicy hot pot evolved from river to land.

The following is about cooking methods, the essential difference. The soup base of Maocai is delicate and drinkable, some of them even contains dozens of Traditional Chinese medicines. In contrast, spicy hot pot was boiled in clear water and then add to broth to it based on customers' taste. However, now many stores directly use soup base to scald ingredients like Maocai in order to save time, which make the taste close to Maocai.

The last one is the way of eating. Maocai is usually served with rice while spicy hot pot with noodles in it as staple food. Allegedly it is because Maocai is too salty to eat without rice. The other is spicy hot pot is sold by bunch. But based on my observation, now majority of it is sold by catty. Just some small stalls in street still sells it by bunch.

That storm of your mood disrupted you all time! Fear? Anxiety? Embarrassment? Alright, you have got into an unsuspecting, tailored whirlpool that your recognition designs for you! This is what we called: spotlight effect.

tit s In 1999, Thomas Gilovich, a professor of psychology at Cornell University, and Kenneth Savitsky, an American psychologist, tried out a trial on why we care others more than what they think of us: They divided some normal testers into two groups with putting on the same shirts, participating in a normal party. They covered one group's shirts with a surprising, even a little weird pattern, the other's shirts were as usual. Nevertheless, the god played a trick!

The conclusion we draw by following our hearts is 50% individuals realized this design. The test appeared there was only a quarter taking care of the distinct, even 10% taking care of them. Your own recognition exerts a significant part in conflict.

Chinese-themed children's book comes into spotlight at London Book Fair

Shu Lin's Grandpa, a children's picture book illustrated by British-Chinese artist Yu Rong, was showcased at the London Book of Sair on Tuesday, sparking heated discussions about how to better tell Chinese stories to international readers.

This book tells a story about Shu Lin, a Chinese immigrant girl, who finds it hard to gain acceptance in her new school, until her grandfather saves the day. The book combines paper-cutting and ink painting with other Chinese elements to create a painting style that is both classical and modern.

Shu Lin's Grandpa, published in Chinese by Dandelion Children's Bookstore and in English by Otter-Barry Books, was shortlisted for the Kate Greenaway Medal this year, which is a prominent children's book award for illustration in Britain. Nowadays, many across the world are eager to learn more about China through stories about Chinese cruitization and contemporary China. At the London Book Fair on Tuesday, Chinese children's bestsellers staged a brainstofming event on how to bring Chinese-themed books to the world audience.

The rich illustrations combined with the celebration of Chinese culture which Shu Lin's Grandpa represents made for a thought-provoking read.
